

CP ENGLISH 12 SYLLABUS

- This course will include a study of English literature from the Old English Period to the Modern Period. Different forms of literature will be studied as well as the characteristics of the different literary periods and how the literature of each period was affected by the history. The course textbook, *Literature: The British Tradition*, will be used primarily.
- Regular reading assignments will be given over the literature. Written assignments will be given periodically over the literature and background information studied.
- Composition is another major focus of this course, which will include a study of different types of writing: personal, analytical, persuasive, and critical. Writing assignments will be completed in these areas as well as during the literature study. In addition, the research paper will be a major composition project. The student handbook, *Write for College*, will be the text used for composition study and review work in grammar, mechanics, and usage.
- Literary terms, poetic devices, vocabulary, spelling, taking notes, outlining, group projects, and oral presentations will also be included during this course.
- Novel reports will also be required. Details on approved authors and the form for these reports will be given at the time the assignment is made.
- Each student must have a notebook/folder/binder for this class. It must be brought to class each day and will include all handouts, class notes, compositions, assignments, vocabulary words, literary terms, poetic devices, graded assignments, etc. for this course. Also, each student will need the school-provided iPad to access the Moodle class page daily.
- Students may also have the opportunity to do journal writing throughout the course. The course notebook will be used for this activity.
