

AP English 12 Favorites Project

During the last days of class in AP English 12 each of you will be working on a Favorites Project. For the project you will compile a “scrapbook” of your favorite literary works. There are seven required categories to include in the scrapbook. The categories are as follows: novels, poems, plays, short stories, literary characters, literary character quotes, and lines from literary works. You will need to choose three examples to include in the scrapbook for each of the required categories.

You will present the examples in the scrapbook on a Google Slide format of your choice. Be creative! You may use typed copy, computer graphics, illustrations, and pictures. Use one page for each example of the required categories. On each page you must include the name of the category, the example with selection title and author’s name, a graphic/illustration, and a 3-5 sentence original explanation of why the example made it into the scrapbook as one of your favorites.

Create the scrapbook on Google Slides on your iPad. The scrapbook must contain a minimum of 21 entries. A final printed copy of your scrapbook needs to be turned in on May 17. Each page of the printed copy must be on 8 ½ x 11 white paper. Your final scrapbook will be presented to the class on May 17/18. Your presentation to the class will be from your iPad and shown on the screen in the classroom through Reflector. The scrapbook is your final project for AP English 12 and will be worth 100 points. Have fun picking your favorites for the Favorites Project!
